

# FISHING GAME

Who do you think caught the fish for the little boys lunch? Was it him? Maybe his Dad? Maybe a local fisherman? Some of Jesus' followers were fishermen before they met Jesus, they were there with Jesus when He fed the five-thousand including Andrew who found the boy with the lunch and took him to Jesus.

Let's go fishing.

For this you will need:

Sticks for the fishing rods (straws, pencils something like that).

String.

Paper Clips.

Split Pins (or Paper Clips).

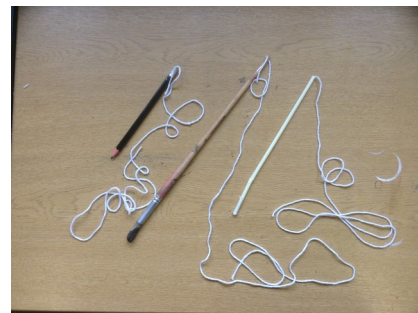
Scissors.

Sticky Tape.

The Fish cut out page (see below).



Step 1 – Cut some string to the length you want and using sticky tape attach it to your fishing rod.



Step 2 – You may need the help of a grown up here. Fold a split pin or a paper clip into a hook shape or a J shape (J for Jesus!). Be careful of the ends of the clips they can be a bit pointy.



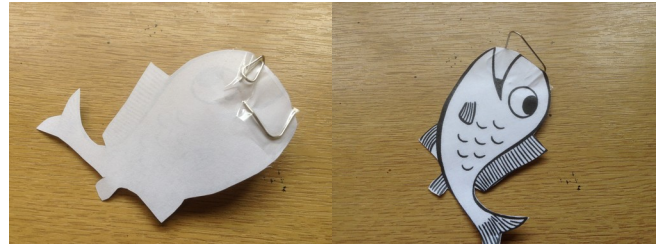
Step 3 – Tie the hook onto the string.



Step 4 – Cut out your fish.



Step 5 – Using paper clips make rings for the hooks to slide into and fasten them to your fish with sticky tape. You may want to ask a grown up to help you and be careful the ends of the paper clips can be pointy.



Step 6 – Go Fishing!



If you want to make it more competitive you can put different points values on the back of the fish and see who can fish out the highest number of points
